1.0 Introduction

This document describes (using examples) how to view BRERC data on the NBN Gateway (National Biodiversity Network Gateway) website: www.nbn.org.uk

1.1 Pre-requisites: NBN Gateway access

You need to have requested access to the NBN Gateway data. Follow the details in the document: How to register on the NBN website and get access to BRERC data.

1.2 Help on the NBN website

1.2.1 NBN Help

On the NBN Home page, click on the 'Help' tab. On 'The Help Desk' page, click on faqs on the left hand side (frequently asked questions), then 'using the gateway'. This can be used on the website or downloaded onto your PC.

On the NBN Home page, click on the 'Useful things' tab. This has information on the NBN Gateway and other topics.

2.0 Accessing BRERC Data


On the NBN Home page, click on the 'Gateway' tab. This will take you to: www.data.nbn.org.uk

2.1 Examples of accessing BRERC data on the NBN Gateway website


2.1.2 Public level of access

BRERC records for fox (Vulpes vulpes) which are available with Public access

Enter 'fox' into the 'Search for Species or Sites' box and click on the search button



This will display a screen where you select the data for fox (Vulpes vulpes), and select 'Interactive distribution map for Vulpes vulpes'



The results screen for the UK distribution of Vulpes vulpes will be displayed:



For detailed help on using the interactive map, click on the Questionmark next to the Interactive map title to get a pop-up help screen. This has lots of useful information and explanations – more than is summarised in this document.

Scroll down the page to see the list of datasets that have been used to draw up this map, at the access level available to the public.


Under the Bristol Regional Environmental Record Centre heading, it will list the latest dataset submitted by BRERC to the NBN Gateway. It will also show the public level of access to this dataset.

Eg Access at 1km resolution, download raw data; No access to sensitive data. To display only BRERC data, scroll down the page to the bottom of the list of datasets, and click on the 'deselect datasets' button. Then scroll back up the list and select BRERC. Scroll back up the page until the map is visible, and click on the 'Refresh the map' button.

To see the BRERC area in more detail, click on the map (in approximately the right place) to zoom in. Keep clicking on the map to zoom in further. (You can deselect/select the BRERC data after this step if preferred)

To move the map, click on the 'Move map' button on the left, then click and drag the map when the 4-headed arrow/cursor appears.

At the public level of access, the map will display a map at the 1km square level of resolution. In this example, 1km squares where fox(es) have been recorded in central Bristol are shaded turquoise; fox(es) recorded at the 2km level of resolution are shaded green.




2.1.2 NBN Gateway Registered users' access

BRERC records for fox (vulpes vulpes) which are available for users who have been granted further access to BRERC data – you will need to apply for further access

Login to the NBN Gateway, and follow the same steps above.

This time the distribution map will show the fox sightings recorded to the 100m level of resolution (full resolution). These records are shown by the red spots on the map:



To see more detail on the individual 100m records:

Click on the 'Select records' button


Click on a red spot

Click on the 'Query records' button

Then click on a red spot

And a results page of the record details will be shown.

If you have been given access to Sensitive records, then the sensitive information will be diaplayed. If you don't have access, then records will be listed as below (Sensitive=N).



To see more detail, click on the map link next to the record. This will display another map, eg at the street map detail (for a 6-figure grid reference).
